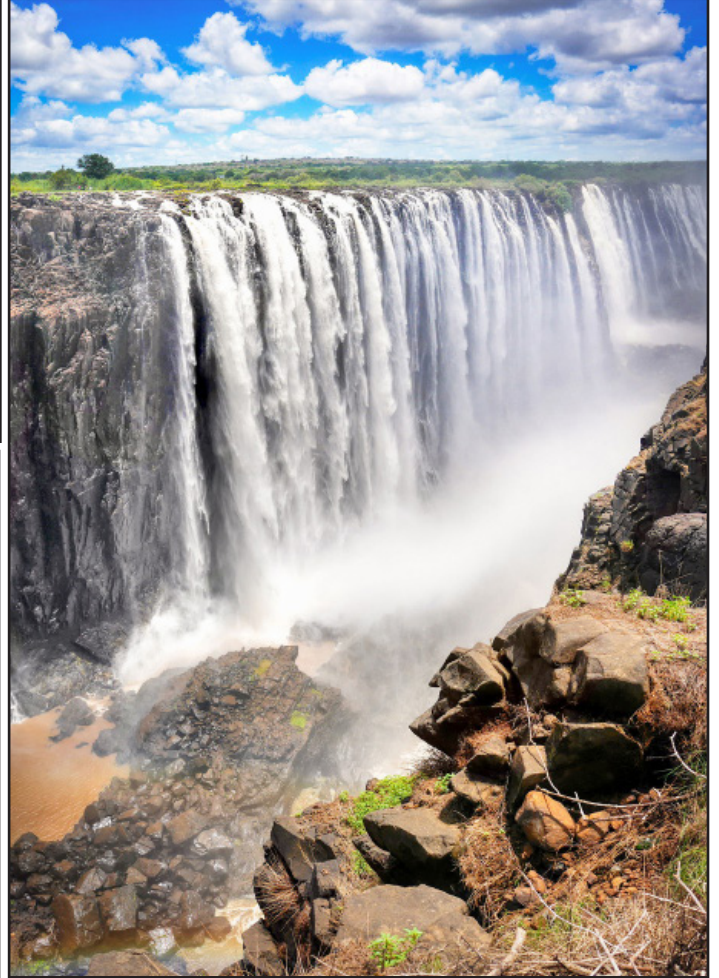


Vision Trip to Northrise University

May 22 - June 3, 2027



DAY 1, SAT, MAY 22

Today we depart on our overnight flight for Africa.

DEPART USA

(meals aloft)

DAY 2, SUN, MAY 23**JOHANNESBURG**

Upon arrival in Johannesburg, we are met and guided to the nearby **City Lodge Hotel** for check-in and overnight.

DAY 3, MON, MAY 24**NDOLA**

Today we fly from Johannesburg to Ndola and check into the **Protea Marriott Hotel** with some time to rest before dinner with Vice Chancellor Dr. and Mrs. Mwewa and Chancellor and Mrs. Zimba. (B,D)

**DAY 4, TUE, MAY 25 NORTHRIS UNIVERSITY/
NDOLA**

We begin our morning at Northrise University with a devotional by Dr. Lameck Mwewa, Vice Chancellor/President. Then we spend some time learning more about the history of Ndola and the Copperbelt, and the impact of Northrise in the community. Lunch is included on campus in the **Compton Guest House**. This afternoon we enjoy a tour of Ndola City. Dinner is included at our hotel this evening. (B,L,D)

**DAY 5, WED, MAY 26 NORTHRIS UNIVERSITY/
NDOLA**

We begin this morning with a devotional by Dr. Moffat Zimba, Chancellor. Then we spend the full day on the campus of Northrise University, learning more about the programs offered by the university, and the ways in which its students and faculty carry out its mission to impact the spiritual and economic transformation of Zambia and Africa. Lunch is included in the **Compton Guest House** and then we have a walking tour of the campus. Later this afternoon we attend Mercy House Graduation, and then we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

**DAY 6, THU, MAY 27 NORTHRIS UNIVERSITY/
NDOLA**

We will spend the full day on the Northrise University campus, hearing from various key campus leaders. The day will start with a devotion from Dr. Lameck Mwewa, Vice Chancellor/President. Lunch will be held in the **Compton Guest House**. In the afternoon we will attend the **Pinning Ceremony** for the graduating nursing students. We return to Ndola this evening with dinner included at our hotel. (B,L,D)

**DAY 7, FRI, MAY 28 NORTHRIS UNIVERSITY/
NDOLA**

Today we have the memorable and meaningful privilege of celebrating Graduation Day at Northrise University with the Class of 2027. (B,D)

DAY 8, SAT, MAY 29**LIVINGSTONE**

We check out of our hotel and depart Ndola, flying to Livingstone, where we check into the **Avani Victoria Falls Resort** for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 9, SUN, MAY 30**VICTORIA FALLS**

After breakfast, we tour Victoria Falls - regarded as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. We walk through the beautiful misty rain forest which surrounds the Falls. Cascading to the depths below are the Main Falls, Horseshoe Falls, and Rainbow Falls, leading to the Boiling Pot, Cataract Island and Livingstone Island. This afternoon we have a game drive through the Mosi-Oa-Tunya Game Reserve. With the help of an experienced guide we may spot some of Africa's finest wildlife, including the endangered white rhino, as well as elephant, giraffe, zebra, buffalo, assorted antelope, warthog, giraffe and many more. (B,D)

DAY 10, MON, MAY 31**CHOBE**

Today we have a full day excursion to Chobe where we enjoy a boat cruise, buffet lunch (drinks not included), and an afternoon game drive. Chobe Park, the third largest national park in Botswana, is located near the borders of Zambia, Zimbabwe and Namibia. Covering approximately 11,700 square kilometers (4,517 square miles) of floodplains, swamps and woodland, Chobe was Botswana's first national park. The park is particularly known for its huge concentration of elephants. (B,L,D)

DAY 11, TUE, JUNE 1**ZAMBEZI RIVER**

Enjoy the morning at leisure. *(We have the opportunity to take part in an optional 15-minute helicopter ride at an extra cost of \$250 per person.)* Lunch is included at our hotel. Later today we cruise on the **Lady Livingstone** - a memorable experience that will take you back to an era where time stood still. The Zambezi River cruise is a superb way to relax and enjoy the beauty of the river. Guests may have the opportunity to see a variety of game including hippo, crocodile, elephant, and sometimes even rhino, as well as different bird species. The cruise includes dinner, along with fantastic photographic opportunities, often featuring spectacular African sunsets! (B,L,D)

DAY 12, WED, JUNE 2**DEPART AFRICA**

Today we transfer to the airport to begin our journey back to the USA. (B, meals aloft)

DAY 13, THU, JUNE 3**RETURN USA**

We arrive in the USA and continue on to our hometown airports. (meals aloft)

All sites listed in the itinerary will be covered but the sequence and days may be altered to adjust to holidays, special closings of sites, air schedules, etc. Hotels listed subject to re-confirmation. This tour is not recommended for those who have mobility limitations since it includes significant amounts of rigorous walking on uneven terrain. Please note that the Americans With Disabilities Act is not applicable outside the USA and facilities in other countries may be sharply limited.

NOT INCLUDED: International airfare to and from Johannesburg is not included in the land-only price. Also not included are meals not listed on itinerary, excess baggage and forwarding of baggage, passport, items of personal nature such as laundry, after lunch and dinner beverages, tips for personal favors, travel protection plans, and any cost resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary and any items not shown herein as being included.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Transatlantic airfare is not included. International airfares will be available around July 15, 2026. Estimated fares from major gateways to/from Johannesburg are: Atlanta \$2620, Dallas \$2400, and Los Angeles \$2750. Dehoney Travel will work to book each person according to their preferred departure city and desired class of service on the flights. Flights from JNB/Ndola, Ndola/Livingstone, and Livingstone/JNB are included.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: A U.S. passport is required and must be valid at least six months beyond the return date of your trip. The name on your air ticket and other travel documents must exactly match your name as it appears on your passport. Please forward a copy of the photo/informational page of your passport when enrolling on the tour. If applying for a new or renewed passport, send the copy as soon as you receive your new passport.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: South Africa requires that passports have two consecutive blank visa pages per entry. Zambia requires three consecutive blank pages in passports. Currently there are no covid-related requirements.

DEVIATION ITINERARY: Any adjustment in standardized air or land itinerary will carry a \$100 fee (for each change) in addition to any additional expense required. This fee is applicable for research projected and/or accepted. In an effort to ensure efficient handling of these requests, Dehoney Travel will require that a tour deposit be received before a deviation request can be processed.

HOTELS: Price is based on double occupancy. A single supplement will be required for those requesting or requiring a single room. When available, single rooms are sometimes smaller than doubles. Single rooms may not be available for this itinerary. If available, single supplement is expected to be \$1,650.

TRANSFERS: Full assistance and transfers are included from airports, hotels, etc. Handling of one piece of luggage per person. Transfers to and within airport of departure from the U.S. are not included.

MEALS AND SIGHTSEEING: Meals are included as per the daily touring descriptions. Use of private vehicles or landcruisers as per the itinerary and driven by English speaking driver/guides. Entrance fees to National Parks and Game Reserves are included. Heritage Fee (\$20 USD per person, per day) at Victoria Falls is included.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: Because of space limitations on the vehicles used, we have included portage for only one check-on bag (combination width, length and height not to exceed 62 inches) in tour cost. You may also take one carry-on which will fit under your airline seat or in the overhead compartment. For the local flights within Africa, size and weight of bags may be limited and larger bags may need to be stored. Every care will be taken to insure protection of your luggage. However, we can accept no responsibility for loss or damage to baggage. Travel insurance, including baggage protection is strongly advised and available through Dehoney Travel, Inc.

GRATUITIES/TAXES: Gratuities for guides, drivers and hotel/lodge personnel are included in the tour price, other than for any personal services rendered. Current U.S. departure, security, customs and inspection taxes and departure taxes will be included in the international ticket purchase.

PAYMENT: Payment can be made by cash, check, e-check or credit card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or Visa). A deposit of \$750 per person is required by January 31, 2027. Because of limited availability in the group and at the lodges, early deposits are strongly recommended. The remaining balance is due by March 8; travelers will receive an invoice from Dehoney Travel prior to the due date.

TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN: Many U.S. health carriers do not provide benefits while outside the country and cancellation penalties can be substantial for many tours. Therefore, Dehoney Travel, Inc. offers a Travel Protection Plan, OneTrip Prime, through Allianz Global Assistance. The Option to Waive Pre-existing Condition Exclusion requires purchase of Travel Protection within 14 days of the date on your tour deposit check or your credit card tour deposit being processed at Dehoney Travel. You may decline the Travel Protection Plan, but a signed disclaimer is required and all charges for cancellation or medical treatment/transport while traveling are your responsibility.

DELAYS, CANCELLATION AND REFUND: Dehoney Travel is not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and cannot reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from delays, re-issuance of air tickets, etc. In event of cancellation, the following scale of charges (per person) will apply when notice of cancellation is given in writing after the booking is confirmed:

From date of deposit until January 31:

\$250 per person.

From February 1 until March 8:

\$750 per person.

March 9 and after:

100% of trip cost is non-refundable.

All cancellation notifications must be made in writing to Dehoney Travel, Inc. Please allow four weeks for cancellation refund processing.

After ticketing of international air, a cancellation penalty of 100% of the airfare is in effect. On or after the date of departure there can be no refund for any service not used.
